Ability to demonstrate problem-solving skills, including time management and space management, and to focus on ensuring efficient operations and maintaining a safe, well-organized, sales floor and environment.

Education & Experience–Bachelor's degree or equivalent work experience with strong communication skills. Knowledge of Not-for-profit organizations. Additional qualifications in retail, customer services, or related fields are favorable

Required Physical Abilities–Ability to stand for extended periods of time and to move and handle merchandise throughout the donation process. Able to bend, reach, lift, climb ladders, and load materials onto shelves and displays. Able to lift 20 lbs. of material and furniture and/or work with co-worker(s) to cooperatively lift and load furniture, and building materials weighing 50 lbs.

Other Requirements–Must be at least 18 years old. Must hold a valid driver's license with a clean driving record and meet state requirements for automobile liability insurance. Must be able to pass a criminal background check.
